Please review membership types:

Individual membership- You must be at least 16 years of age

Family membership- for families that have skaters under the age of 16, all family members do not need to be skaters, but can still be club members

Associate membership-Used for skaters who wish to keep their current home club, but still enjoy testing privileges, as well as other club benefits at I/WSA. If skater is not 16 years if age, you must join **Associate family membership**.

Professional membership- for I/WSA staff professionals

Collegiate membership-for skaters currently enrolled in college, this is a one time fee for a four year consecutive period

Introductory membership-for individuals who have never been a full or individual member of a United States Figure Skating Club

CODE OF CONDUCT

INTRODUCTION: The Indiana / World Skating Academy Figure Skating Club is a 120 plus member USFSA sanctioned Club of ice skating enthusiasts with individual, pairs, dance, and adult competitive and recreational figure skaters. The Club has enjoyed exceptional success over its more than fifteen years of existence and has developed nationally ranked skaters through the hard work of world class coaches and the committed and diligent support of parents, family, friends and donors. As with any large, volunteer organization with a diverse and talented number of participants, the Indiana / World Skating Academy Figure Skating Club (I/WSA FSC referred to as "the Club"), has faced its share of challenges. Coordinating and executing world class competitive events such as Indy Challenge, a USFSA selection competition for Pairs and Dance Skaters, is a major endeavor. Also, I/WSA FSC hosts central Indiana's very own Skate Indy, a local competition attended by skaters throughout the Region. Executing these competitions as well as hosting numerous test sessions, mentoring and training events, and exhibitions requires extensive planning, financial resources, shared vision, and a desire to represent professional excellence in figure skating on and off the ice.

Though membership and leadership have changed numerous times over the years, the club has consistently pursued the principle of excellence in what we do for the benefit of the members at large, the skaters, the guest competitors, the guest officials and the advancement of the sport of Figure Skating in general.

To encourage an environment at our Home rink which meets the ideals of our Club and USFSA and in order to advance the tenets of Figure Skating, the I/WSA FSC Board adopts the enclosed Code of Conduct for it's members.

CODE OF CONDUCE FROM THE BYLAWS

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and (1) to function as an amateur athletic association to foster international, national, and sectional competition in the sport of figure skating; (2) to encourage and give guidance and help fur the full participation in the sport of figure skating by all persons, regardless of age, gender, race, religion, national origin or ancestry; (3) to encourage and promote good sportsmanship; (4) to encourage the practice, instruction, and advancement of amateur skating on ice in all its forms, including compulsory figures, free skating, moves in the field, pairs skating, ice dancing and basic skills; (5) to educate and inform the public regarding figure skate, with emphasis on its pleasure and healthful and other benefits; (6) to publish and disseminate information concerning figure skating by bulletin, paper, book, magazine or otherwise; (7) to sponsor or co-sponsor, produce or co-produce, to host or co-host, or cooperate in the sponsorship production or hosting of ice carnivals, ice shows, testing, or amateur figure skating competitions; (8) and generally to do and perform such other acts as may be necessary, advisable, proper, or incidental in the realization of the objects and purposes of this organization, including the raising of money to support the activities by dues, fees, carnivals, sales of tickets and merchandise, and other lawful means, and to carry out the general policies of United States Figure Skating Association; and (9) including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Volunteer hour requirements!

Running an effective, highly-functioning club requires a massive amount of effort on the part of our volunteers. During the (July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012) membership season, I/WSA FSC requires mandatory volunteer hours from its members. Volunteer hours will be recorded at all events. (Volunteer Binder usually found at registration desk or with test chair, must be signed by authorized person upon completion of hours.)

We know that for the volunteers who continually give countless hours to the various events we host, this will not be a difficult requirement to meet. Some others may have to make the decision to step up and give just a bit more. This requirement is designed to make being an I/WSA FSC member fair for everyone. This is absolutely necessary to have a smooth running organization, and to operate at the clubs full potential.

I/WSA FSC Volunteer Hour Requirements

15 Volunteer hours will be required of each full and Introductory member family, 10 for each Associate member family and Individual members, and 5 hours for coaches. 5 of those hours or (2 for coaches) can be bought out at a rate of \$10.00 per hour and will be due by the end of the membership year (June 30.) All remaining hours must be served. If failure to fulfill requirement is not met by the end of the season, you will be flagged “not in good standing”, and skater will be ineligible to receive stipends for qualifying competitions. This could also jeopardize one’s “member in good standing” status, for USFSA and make one ineligible to participate in competitions, test sessions and other Club functions.

Volunteer hours will not be required if member has a home address located 100 (plus) miles from rink **and** does not train at I/WSA at least 2 days per week. Families with coaches and skaters will be required to meet the family hour requirement. Members of the board who attend 9 out of 12 monthly meetings can earn a 5 hour credit. Any family member age 12(plus) can earn hours. Members joining after January 1 will be required to give 5 hours (full) and 2 (assoc. and individual.) No buy outs allowed.
