This competition is open to all qualified eligible skaters who are members in good standing of US FIGURE SKATING and **will be governed by the rules in the most current US FIGURE SKATING Rulebook or rule changes** as provided by US Figure Skating Governing Council meeting. The purpose of this non-qualifying competition is to provide an excellent competitive experience to all levels of pairs and to bring together many of the top pair teams from the United States. With this in mind, the committee has invited National and International judges.

ENTRIES: All entries must be submitted on the Official Entry Form and **POSTMARKED** to the Registrar on or before June 16, 2011. This announcement may be copied and distributed as necessary. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and will carry a **\$ 37.00 late fee. ALL FEES ARE IN U.S. DOLLARS.**

REFUND POLICY: NO REFUNDS will be given after the close of entries. Entry fees paid for canceled events will be returned following the completion of the competition.

ELIGIBILITY: When events parallel US FIGURE SKATING qualifying competitions, THE COMPETITORS MAY SKATE UP ONE LEVEL FROM THEIR CURRENT PAIR TEST. SKATING DOWN FROM THE CURRENT TEST LEVEL WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. US FIGURE SKATING eligibility rules will be in effect. **

MUSIC: ICEtrax is similar to software already in place at the standard U.S. National Championships, the World Championships, and other elite competitions where all skaters' music is uploaded to a computer and played from that computer program, thus eliminating most common CD errors such as skipping, unpredictable volume, and CDs that can't be read.

All pair teams are required to upload their music at www.ICEtrax.net by **Wednesday, July 20, 2011. Only one member of each pair team needs to upload the music to ICEtrax.**

Any pair team that does not upload their music to ICEtrax prior to **Wednesday, July 20, 2011, can do that at the ICEtrax vendor table at the competition. A late fee \$5 per program will be charged, payable at the Indy Challenge Registration desk.**

All pair teams are still required to bring two copies of their music to the competition: one to keep available rink side as a back up, and one available to submit for competition playing (as you would for any other competition).

Note to Coaches: *It is best for each pair team to login and create their own account. Issues may arise if one individual loads the music for multiple pairs under one account.*

AWARDS: Distinctive Indy Challenge medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers in every event.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Please be aware of your time to get to IWSA. There is ongoing major street construction and a huge event at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway that weekend. If you are staying at a hotel that is not within walking distance of IWSA, please allow plenty of extra time to arrive at the rink for your event.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE: The Official Competition Schedule will be determined after the close of entries by the Chief Referee and will be distributed to all competitors and coaches.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT: All Pairs and competing under the IJS must submit planned program content sheets for each program by July 15, 2011 at Midnight. PRACTICE ICE: Official practice ice times for Junior and Senior teams will begin early Thursday afternoon, July 28. General practice ice for other levels will be also available. Please see practice ice registration form. Walk-on practice sessions can be purchased on site at \$14.00 per person per session at the registration desk. **Practice ice is not included in the entry fees.** Advance-purchase practice ice before dead line is \$12.00 per person.

VIDEO: Ledin Video (www.ledinvideo.com) will be videotaping the entire competition. Place your order on the first day of the competition. No other videotaping will be allowed except from the stands.

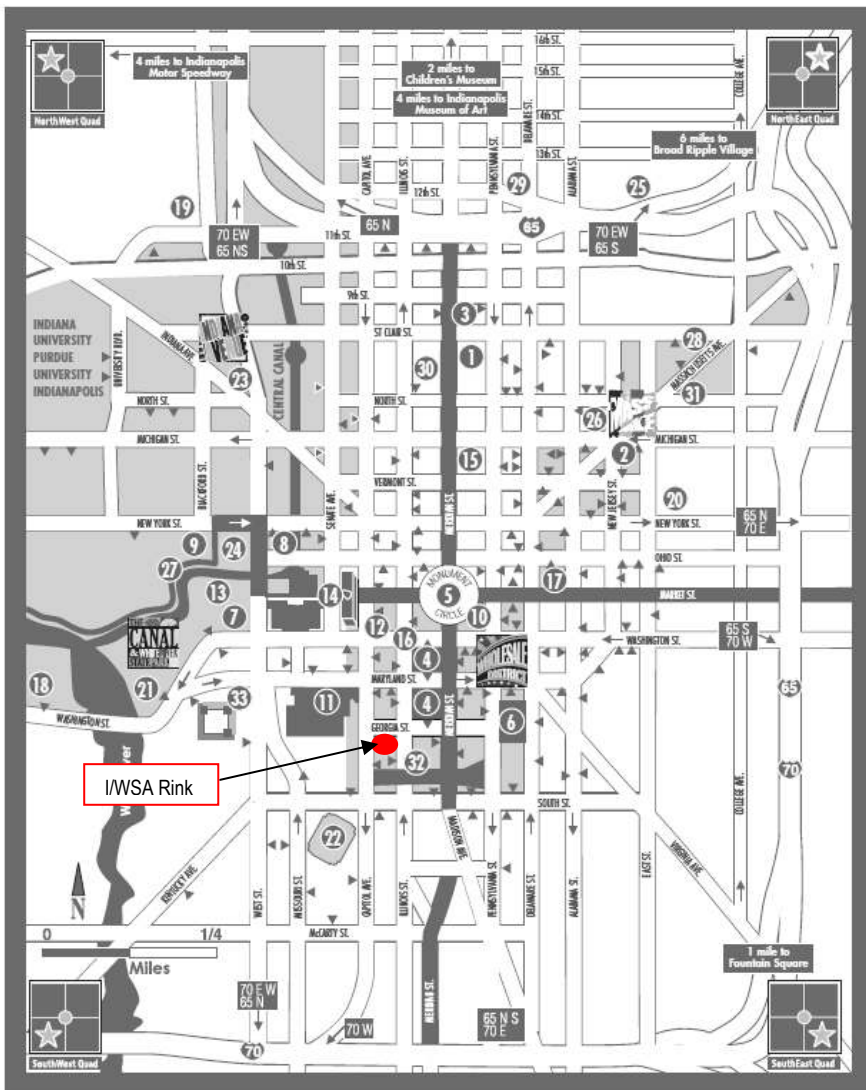
